
MADRID VIRTUAL TOUR



We will start our tour from **Puerta del Sol**, the epicenter of Madrid. Our guide will walk through **Street Arenal** to get you to the main Square of Madrid, **Plaza Mayor**, where you will learn about the Habsburg dynasty, collection of events between the 16th and 17th centuries. The tour of the Renaissance and Baroque buildings of this era is perhaps one of the most picturesque in Madrid.

We will continue visiting the **Mercado de San Miguel**, historic market space that retains its original iron structure of the early twentieth century. We will get to the **Plaza de la Villa**, one of Madrid's best-preserved historical monuments. It was one of the main medieval centers of Madrid, since three streets start there, corresponding to the original city design: Codo, Cordón and Madrid. Our visit via **calle Mayor**, will take us to marvel at the incredible history of the **Almudena Cathedral**, with its first stone laid in 1883 but not completed for more than 100 years. We will get to the largest royal palace in Western Europe, a must-visit for all, the **Royal Palace**

Our visit will end in Opera District, where we will find and discover **Teatro Real**, the opera house.
